DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that Lewis University offers a **Summer Undergraduate Research Experience (SURE)** program? This unique 10-week program allows students from various disciplines to engage in collaborative research, working closely with faculty mentors on projects specific to their fields. Beyond conducting research, participants come together weekly to discuss essential topics like research ethics, data analysis, scientific writing, and resume building. Students gain hands-on experience that accelerates their academic and research careers, often leading to conference presentations or published work. The program culminates in a research symposium where students showcase their summer accomplishments to the community.




