


HELLO AUTUMN!

2025 Mission Trip to the Philippines Recap and June 2026 Trip Opportunity

From June 8 to June 22, 2025, with the support of generous donors, five students and five faculty/staff members from Lewis, traveled to Bacolod City, Philippines to build community, serve those in need, and experience a new culture. Throughout the two-week trip, the group stayed at the retreat center at LaSalle University and helped build a home for a family of four in Gawad Kalinga Village, managing to do it two days ahead of schedule. They also spent time with members of the community, learning about their culture, and cooking local cuisine. One trip highlight was visiting homes built by Lewis Mission Trip participants over the past 15 years and distributing gifts collected during Mission & Ministry's Christmas Giving Tree. Before returning to the U.S., the group gifted 2000 lbs. of rice to the Gawad Kalinga Village community, enough to feed 102 families for two weeks.


